



Project Link is the out-of-school time program provided to district families by the Westlake Board of Education. We strive to furnish students with a safe, nurturing, and enriching environment in which they may excel during before and after school hours. Project Link builds upon the daily instructional experience by providing standards based opportunities for free-play, age-appropriate activities, and academic tutoring. Project Link serves over 500 students, grades K-8, and is located at Westlake Elementary School, Dover Intermediate School and Lee Burneson Middle School.

Project Link is in session each instructional day during the school year from 6:30 A.M. until the start of the school day and again from the conclusion of the school day until 6:00 P.M. All day kindergarten students are eligible to attend both the A.M. and P.M. sessions of Project Link. **Half-day kindergarten students are eligible to attend A.M. Project Link if they are enrolled in A.M. kindergarten, and P.M. kindergarten students are eligible to attend P.M.
