WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the "Board") of this School District (the "District"), pursuant to this resolution desires to authorize the execution and delivery by the District of a Customer Supply Agreement between the District and FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (the "Customer Supply Agreement"), pursuant to which the District will purchase electricity generation at a discount for its school facilities; and

DRAFT RESOLUTION FOR CONSIDERATION Presented for Further Discussion on April 18, 2011

In accordance with our fiduciary duty to manage District resources responsibly, we hereby adopt the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, according to the most recent financial projection presented by the Treasurer of the Westlake City School District revenue is expected to be flat, at approximately \$50 Million per year, through the year 2015 (notwithstanding carry-over funds). Over the course of the same period, total expenditures increase each year, to \$61.8 Million. More specifically:

WHEREAS, according to the Ohio Department of Education, the Westlake City School District spends at least \$1,500 more per pupil each year than similar Ohio districts;

WHEREAS, based on the approximately 4,000 students in our District, we spend at least \$6 million more each year than the Ohio Department of Education's similar districts;

WHEREAS, over the next five years, District operating expenses are projected to increase by approximately \$2 million per year, with an additional tax increase as a result of an operating levy expected in 2012;

WHEREAS, Westlake taxpayers should anticipate a second phase for new and renovated school buildings, at an estimated cost of \$45 million; in addition to the \$84 million already voted upon in 2010, also for new and renovated school buildings;

WHEREAS, Westlake City School District tax revenue is static or declining, the amount of state aid it receives is declining, and its student population is not increasing;

WHEREAS, as a result of rapidly increasing expenses and static or declining revenues, the Westlake City School District forecasts a **\$14,240,060** budget deficit (all funds) in 2015;

WHEREAS, expenses in fiscal year 2008; 2009 & 2010 were less than incoming revenue received;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and adopted by the Westlake Board of Education, the Superintendant of the Westlake City School District is instructed to develop a long-term financial plan, in conjunction with the Treasurer of the Westlake City School District, and other members of the Administration, whereby anticipated expenses DO NOT exceed anticipated revenue, notwithstanding carry-over funds.

This long-term financial plan should coincide with the approval of the 2011-2012 fiscal year budget; and address the need to reduce current expenses by decreasing the expenditure gap consistent with available incoming resources, notwithstanding carry-over funds. Additionally, at a minimum, the plan should accomplish the following:

- Continue to fulfill the mission of the Westlake School District by providing the very best educational opportunities and programs for our children;
- Establish financial targets, for the next five (5) years, to balance expenses with expected tax revenue. Financial targets and/or financial models should take into account anticipated legislative changes as a result of Senate Bill 5 -- dependent on the best information available at the time of this analysis; along with other proposed or expected revenue enhancements and/or new program initiatives;
- Within five (5) years, average expenses per pupil should be less or equal to similar demographically equivalent districts in Ohio;

- New financial targets are aligned to allow for a yearly increase in total dollars spent on classroom instruction; while also decreasing the amount spent per pupil to more closely align with the state average, for demographically equivalent districts;
- New financial targets are aligned to allow for continued and new programming, such as all-day kindergarten, International Baccalaureate (IB), foreign language curriculum; and/or other programming defined in the Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP); and to account for the increase in spending as a result of addressing facility deficiencies.
- Reverse the trend toward increased (higher) taxes, with the goal to lower the tax burden on all residents in the City of Westlake.
