RESOLUTION NO
A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF AN ADDITIONAL TAX LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CURRENT EXPENSES TO THE ELECTORS OF THE WESTLAKE CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, PURSUANT TO SECTION 5705.21 OF THE REVISED CODE.
WHEREAS, on July 29, 2013, this Board adopted a resolution, pursuant to Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, declaring it necessary to levy an additional []-mill tax levy for a continuing period of time and requesting the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer to certify the total current tax valuation of the School District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that levy; and
WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer has certified that the total tax valuation of the District is \$[], and that the estimated property tax revenue to be produced by that []-mill additional levy would be \$[] annually during the life of the levy, assuming the tax valuation remains constant throughout the life of the levy;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Westlake City School District, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, <i>two-thirds</i> of all members of said Board elected thereto concurring, that
Section 1. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the amount of taxes which may be raised by the Board of Education of the Westlake City School District within the ten-mill limitation on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of this School District, and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation for the purpose of current expenses in the amount of []mills for a continuing period of time.
Section 2. The question of an additional []-mill tax levy for the purpose of current expenses for a continuing period of time, beginning with the tax list and duplicate for the year 2013, the proceeds of which levy first would be available to this Board in calendar year 2014, shall be submitted under the provisions of Section 5705.21 of the Revised Code to the electors of the Westlake City School District at an election to be held therein on November 5, 2013, as authorized by law, and that election shall be held at the regular places of voting in this District as established by the Board of Elections of Cuyahoga County, or otherwise, within the times provided by law and shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.

<u>Section 3</u>. The form of the ballot to be cast at the election on the question of this tax levy shall be substantially as follows:
