 - a. ODE submitted to federal government waiver request from NCLB requirements with new standards. Feds asked for innovative reforms. Waiver offers higher student achievement.
 - b. Ohio waiver includes AYP replacement, reforming SES, targeted assistance for low-performing schools, cut red tape, letter grade report cards. Tougher standards and tests are already on the way. Waiver decision will be made in a few months. Changes would begin with 2012-13 school year. New report card change would happen in August 2012.
 - c. Tom Mays: Target assistance for low-performing schools, where will money come from?
 - i. There probably won't be more money, but it may be distributed differently.
 - d. Nate Cross: will this compare us to everyone or like districts?
 - i. All districts in Ohio.
 - e. Mays: Explain the district performance gap.
