Resolution 19- 197

A. Resolution Declaring Transportation Impractical for Certain Identified Students Pursuant to the Requirements of Ohio Revised Code 3327 and the Procedures Set Forth by the Ohio Department of Education

WHEREAS, the student(s) identified, in the attachment, have been determined to be residents of this school district, and eligible for transportation services; and

WHEREAS, after a careful evaluation of all available options, it has been determined that it is impractical to provide transportation for these student(s) to their selected school(s); and

WHEREAS, the following factors, as identified in Ohio Revised Code 3327.02, have been considered:

- 1. The time and distance required to provide the transportation;
- 2. The number of pupils to be transported;
- 3. The cost of providing transportation in terms of equipment, maintenance, personnel, and administration;
- 4. Whether similar or equivalent service is provided to other pupils eligible for transportation;
- 5. Whether and to what extent the additional service unavoidably disrupts current transportation schedules;
- 6. Whether other reimbursable types of transportation are available.

WHEREAS, the option of offering payment-in-lieu of transportation is provided in Ohio Revised Code; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Westlake City School District, Cuyahoga County, Ohio hereby approves the declaration that it is impractical to transport the students identified here in and offers the parent(s)/guardian(s) of students named on the attachment, payment in lieu of transportation.
