a. Update on Primary Years International Baccalaureate Programme – Colleen Mudore and Deb Wadden – IB Coordinators

Colleen Mudore and Deb Wadden spoke about the candidate/authorization process and reported all four elementaries remain candidate schools awaiting IB authorization.

#### b. WHS Presidential Scholars

Superintendent Palmer recognized three WHS Presidential Scholars and noted that only 141 students nationwide are selected for this accolade.

#### D. Superintendent's Report & Master Facility Plan Phase I Report

Superintendent Palmer noted the following:

- 1. There have been numerous parent inquiries about the standardized testing occurring throughout the District and also raised the concern about the implications of parents 'opting-out' of the test(s). He noted that State Superintendent Ross has proposed changes to the current testing requirements which may provide relief to students, staff and parents.
- 2. Unveiled the proposed 2015-16 school calendar and stated the District will need to comply with applicable law in transitioning the school calendar from days to hours the next school year. Due to public hearing requirements, Superintendent Palmer explained that this meeting will serve as the public notice, and action will be slated for the next available meeting after March 27<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. The 20/20 Committee's recent meeting focused on engaging stakeholders.
- 4. Mr. Kocevar reported on Phase I and the field house project. All bids received on the field house were over the estimated construction project budget by 10% and by law must be rejected.
