## G. Master Facility Plan Phase I Report

Bob Teitenberg, Turner, gave a construction update. Todd Wrobleski, MKC, spoke about the schematic design and resultant budget to date.

#### H. Director of Business Affairs Report

Dave Puffer noted the following:

- 1. Updated the Board on maintenance repairs, particularly potholes at the high school.
- 2. Spring sports activity is underway.

#### I. Board Items

Sullivan: Noted a local fundraiser will be held for Suicide Prevention.

Sullivan: Asked questions about Dr. Keenan's Superintendent Report.

Keenan: Responded to Mr. Sullivan with several examples regarding his inquiry.

Sullivan: Spoke about the school district's low accountability for teachers.

<u>Keenan</u>: Responded to Mr. Sullivan the District has several processes in place that obtain accountability for certificated staff.

<u>Sullivan</u>: Spoke about a lack of accountability in the District's educational system and the need for major reform.

#### 1. Review of Board Processes

<u>Mays</u>: Reviewed Board procedure with all members specifically regarding Sunshine Laws and Board member communication. He further asked the Board to consider using OSBA/legal counsel to discuss this matter further.

<u>Cross</u>: Stated he would like legal counsel and OSBA to come in and speak on this matter. Sullivan: Stated he would like to reflect on the matter further.

<u>Rocco</u>: Spoke about the need for open communication and how business should be discussed at a public meeting. Noted she is not in favor of spending money to have legal counsel discuss what is common sense.

<u>Winter</u>: Spoke about Board member expectations and their performance with respect to governance.

Mays: Asked each Board member to review policy BBF-E – Board Member Code of Ethics.

<u>Sullivan</u>: Spoke of criticism between members of the Board and asked the Board to consider watching the tape of the last meeting.

Cross: Would like to close the discussion and move on to the next item.

#### 2. Draft Spending Resolution

<u>Cross</u>: Submitted a draft resolution for Board consideration. He further spoke about his recent editorial submission.

<u>Sullivan</u>: Stated his support for Mr. Cross' efforts.

<u>Rocco</u>: Stated she wanted to clarify the premise that the 'District will run out of money' is not a new issue, and looks forward to discussing this topic further on April 18<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Winter</u>: Spoke about local control in combination with funding and the balance expected by the community.

Sullivan: Spoke about his belief the District is on an unsustainable financial path.

<u>Mays</u>: Disagrees with Mr. Sullivan's statement and believes Board members have worked within the financial parameters afforded by local taxpayers. He further asked members of the Board to come with solutions to the issues in April.
