• Inquired about the details of Turner's oversight responsibilities once their contracted hours have been completed on the project.

 Asked if Tarazzo flooring was still an alternate on the project. Turner indicated it was bid as an alternate but already accepted. They could, however, ask the contractor for a deduct change order.

• The Board needs to discuss the recent issue of alternate backfill material proposed by the general contractor. Turner indicated the contract requires engineered fill. The contractor is proposing to utilize alternate material at an additional cost of approximately \$45,000 citing concerns over site drainage.
