A. Performing Arts Center Construction Update

Representatives present: Mark Dent, Lou Trostel

<u>Dent</u>: Provided a project status report to the Board. He discussed the close-out status with each of the prime contractors: Summit, Fortney and Castle.

<u>Wargo</u>: What is the status of the outstanding contractual issue with the architect? <u>Dent</u>: The issue is ongoing, and the architect still needs to respond. In addition, there may be another contractual item to discuss regarding some electrical re-inspection work.

<u>Wargo</u>: She feels the Board shouldn't mix the Errors and Omission issue with additional services that might be requested of the architect.

Beal: Agrees with Mrs. Wargo.

<u>Wargo</u>: Concerned with any potential electrical safety issues and recommends the administration develop a mitigation plan immediately.

Smanik: What is the current occupancy status of the Performing Arts Center?

<u>Slocum</u>: The City confirmed the facility is still approved for occupancy despite the minor electrical issues found.

O'Malley: He is also concerned with the safety of the facility, and indicated the District should expedite an electrical review.

<u>Wargo</u>: We should not occupy the facility until an independent review has been conducted clearing the facility for use.

O'Malley: There have been other issues with the electrical contractor in the past.

The Board is responsible to make sure there are no outstanding issues.

<u>Wargo</u>: The electrical review issue must be addressed immediately, and stated she is not opposed to placing blame on the appropriate contractor.

<u>Smanik</u>: If the facility is temporarily closed, an approximate timeline for the reopening should be constructed to allow district groups the opportunity to modify their schedules.

O'Malley: When is the issue with the TV studio going to be fixed?

<u>Slocum</u>: Indicated he is checking with the contractor on the proposed time frame for completion.

O'Malley: Are all costs for this project covered by bond monies?

<u>Costanza</u>: Yes. The costs for this project only use bond proceeds and interest earned on the proceeds.

<u>Smanik</u>: Are as-builts being revised with the changes occurring in the late stages of the project?

<u>Trostel</u>: Indicated he will check on this matter. He is concerned, though, about the electrical as-builts.

Mr. Beal was appointed President Pro Tem.

President D'Ettorre Wargo exited the meeting at 8:06 a.m.
