A. Performing Arts Center Construction Update

Representatives present: Jay Waddell, Karen Sweeney, Lou Trostle, Joel Schwartz

Jay Waddell provided the Board with an update on the progress of the Performing Arts Center construction to date.

Overview of items addressed:

- The orchestra pit is complete and structural steel is currently being erected.
- The site is being backfilled.
- New electrical service is complete.
- Additional masonry is being added daily.
- The general contractor is working on an accelerated schedule that should modify the January 2005 timeline.
- The District needs to bid remaining items such as the orchestra shell, security, band and TV studio equipment.
- The general contractor has submitted a request for an additional \$56,000 due to higher than expected steel costs for the project.

## LeChaix:

• Asked Waddell if there are any other items that could cause additional delays in the schedule?

#### Waddell:

• He commented that although something can always materialize on a project, most items seem to be under control to date.

# O'Malley:

• Asked Waddell how seating for the project is purchased?

## Schwartz:

• The District included seating in their bid specifications. The general contractor, Summit, will purchase but the District needs to verify the specs and approve a seat mockup. Mr. Schwartz indicated he will call the seating manufacturer to get this process moving.

# O'Malley:

• When will the District be receiving the revised recovery schedule?

#### Waddell:

• It should be forthcoming in the next week or so.

#### Schwartz:

• Indicated the exterior signage mockup should be forthcoming.

# Waddell:

• Indicated the project is still within the total approved \$8.7m budget.

The Board unanimously agreed to proceed with the purchase of the orchestra shell.

Mrs. D'Ettorre Wargo exited the meeting at 7:45 a.m.

#### Costanza:

• The District needs to buy a concert piano for the Performing Arts Center. The cost is projected to be \$40,000 for a new piano and \$30,000 for a refurbished one.

#### O'Mallev:

• When is the topping off ceremony?

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• It will be May 25<sup>th</sup> at noon.

# O'Malley:

• When will the architect discuss its omission?

## Schwartz:

• The principal, Paul Westlake, indicated that he would prefer to discuss this at a time later in the project.

#### Board:

- Unanimously agreed the architect should formally respond to this issue now and not wait until the end of the project. Mr. Schwartz indicated he will pass on the wishes of the Board to Mr. Westlake.
