H. Board Items

- a. President Rocco commented that she has received thank you notes from the 2009 Board Scholarship recipients.
- b. Architect Firm Presentation

<u>Todd Wrobleski</u> introduced members of the pre-planning and planning design team from MKC Associates, district architects.

Rocco: Asked Mr. Wrobleski if MKC will involve Westlake staff in the planning process.

<u>Steve Miller</u>: Indicated staff involvement is critical to the process. In addition, he stated MKC will review the Community Survey and visit school building locations.

<u>Marinucci</u>: Stated he was confused by Mr. Miller's comment and asked what type of information they will be reviewing from the survey.

<u>Dan Obrynba</u>: Responded to Mr. Marinucci that reviewing the Survey will be helpful to the Master Planning process.

<u>Marinucci</u>: Asked Superintendent Keenan whether or not there are there enough checks and balances in the proposed planning process timeline.

<u>Keenan</u>: Indicated to Mr. Marinucci that regardless of design, there certainly will be ongoing dialogue with the Board of Education and felt there is enough opportunity for Board input. In addition, the Board has tentatively scheduled a meeting dedicated to facilities on June 15 and MKC will be present as well.

<u>Dan Obrynba</u>: Indicated to the Board that sometimes districts will utilize a board sub-committee to handle interim issues to reduce the frequency of required special meetings.

<u>Marinucci</u>: Stated the 20/20 committee could be advantageous to this part of the process and also provide periodic updates to the Board on selected milestones.

<u>Keenan</u>: Commented that the District will have a mechanism in place to update the Board on every step of the process up to the presentation date in August.

Mays: Asked Mr. Miller how MKC defines bond issue support.

<u>Dan Obrynba</u>: Indicated to Mr. Mays they see themselves as the support to the District's communications consultant, in attending meetings, responding to technical questions, and helping with public relations.

<u>Mays</u>: Asked Mr. Miller what MKC did in the way of bond issue support for the eight districts referenced in their proposal.

<u>Steve Miller</u>: Stated to Mr. Mays they offered many pre-bond campaign service activities tailored to the districts' need.

<u>Keenan</u>: Indicated to the Board the District will need to make sure they don't trump the current strategy of using Burges, and MKC should instead compliment this strategy.

<u>Marinucci</u>: Asked Mr. Wrobleski how MKC will help us determine whether to proceed as an OSFC project or not.

<u>Todd Wrobleski</u>: Indicated to Mr. Marinucci that hard costs can contribute to a slight difference in overall project budget, but usually there is greater savings in the soft costs. He further indicated that project delivery is a bit slowed with an OSFC initiative.

<u>Mays</u>: Asked MKC if they can quantify projected utility savings with any proposed design. <u>Doug Lancashire (Osborn Engineering)</u>: Indicated to Mr. Mays they can, but one needs to factor in things such as current building configuration vs. projected configuration to make an apples-to-apples comparison.

Sullivan: Asked MKC what it costs to build a new facility.

<u>Todd Wrobleski</u>: Indicated to Mr. Sullivan that current building estimates would suggest \$223/sq.ft. and roughly 14-16% for budgeted soft costs.

<u>Mays</u>: Asked MKC other than Bradley Road, are there other school sites we could immediately build upon?

<u>Todd Wrobleski</u>: Indicated to Mr. Mays that based upon their initial review, Lee Burneson, Hilliard and Bassett seem to exhibit capacity for immediate construction.
