*Meeting Open to Public (15 Minutes) – Superintendent Candidate questions

<u>Scott Kutz</u>: How could Westlake Schools elevate their technological program for their students, particularly in Science and Math?

<u>Keenan</u>: We need to look at content standards and the curriculum and make sure we are preparing students for the world.

Kathy Axcell: How would you continue to motivate and drive our existing administration?

<u>Keenan</u>: I would continue to update the CIP, be a steward of the District's vision, and continue to support individuals in their roles.

<u>Harry Applegate</u>: What about teaching additional foreign language to our students?

<u>Keenan</u>: I was involved with the Business Advisory Council at Kenston where they are currently looking at additional language offerings and culture appreciation.

Kelly Smith: What have you done to support the proposed funding amendment?

<u>Keenan</u>: At Kenston, we have taken an active approach. We desperately need an alternative to the current system.

Deb Yandala: What is your opinion on music and fine arts in K-12 education?

<u>Keenan</u>: I believe in a well-rounded education. Students need to have opportunities such as music and the arts to excel.

<u>Ann Beyer</u>: Have you implemented a technology plan to assist PTAs and parents on obtaining contributions?

<u>Keenan</u>: A technology plan is important as well as offering pilot technical programs. In doing so though, one must understand the District's capacity as well.

Kathy Axcell: What would be your most important role here at Westlake?

Keenan: Understanding the people and helping others see the big picture.

<u>Bech Veccio</u>: What is the difference between the Assistant Superintendent and Superintendent roles? What about coming to Westlake?

<u>Keenan</u>: It can mean different things to different districts, but I have had a wide spectrum of experiences in various roles. I think I'm prepared for the opportunity. Anyone in this role, though, will always have a learning curve.

Beth Veccio: What are Westlake's weaknesses?
