B. Update and Discussion on Master Facility Planning Process – Consideration of QSCB Program

<sup>\*</sup>Hearing of Public (15 Minutes) Agenda Items – None.

<u>Sullivan</u>: Asked the Superintendent what other type of hooks bind you by making application for the QSCB bonds, and does it force the Board's decision-making process on a bond issue in any way.

<u>Marinucci</u>: Asked the Superintendent about the prevailing wage required by OSFC and whether the District could apply for Pool A or B funds.

<u>Pepera</u>: Stated the District is only eligible to apply for Pool B funds. If the Board chooses to ultimately accept an allocation, they would have 120 days from the bond issue approval date to issue the QSCB bonds.

#### C. MKC Update

Dave Puffer, Business Manager, provided an update on the workings of MKC Associates.

• To date, MKC representatives have spoken with faculty and all District departments, evaluated engineering needs which take into account programmatic requirements, and reviewed existing master plan options and schematic designs.

Dave Puffer provided a mobile unit update.

- Lee Burneson requires 1 unit
- Parkside requires 2 units
- MKC is currently working with the City on location approval.

Discussion ensued on compliance with City zoning requirements. Mr. Puffer noted that our engineer has identified a circuit capacity issue at Burneson that could impact the scope of the project.

Marinucci: Asked the Superintendent what the projected 2009-10 enrollment looks like.

<u>Keenan</u>: Stated we are seeing a slight increase at this point at the elementary level consistent with past years.

<u>Marinucci</u>: He stated it is important to clearly footnote all public correspondence that a project including a new high school doesn't mean we eliminate the PAC.
