The Treasurer, or Treasurer Pro Tempore, as the case may be, advised the Board that the notice requirements of Section 121.22 of the Revised Code and the implementing rules adopted by the Board pursuant thereto were complied with for the meeting.

Mrs. Leszynski moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 13-225

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE RECEIPT OF A REDUCED FEDERAL INTEREST SUBSIDY PAYMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE DELIVERY OF A NOTICE RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, at an election held on May 4, 2010, on the question of issuing bonds of the Westlake City School District, Ohio (the "School District") in the aggregate principal amount of \$84,056,066 and of levying taxes outside the ten-mill limitation to pay the debt charges on those bonds, the requisite majority of those voting on the question voted in favor of it (the "2010 Voter Authorization"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 2010 Voter Authorization and a resolution adopted by this Board on June 28, 2010, and a Certificate of Award executed under the authority of that resolution and dated August 10, 2010 (collectively, the "Original Bond Legislation"), the District issued its \$84,055,000 School Improvement Bonds, Series 2010, dated August 24, 2010 (the "Series 2010 Bonds"), consisting of \$15,630,000 School Improvement Bonds, Series 2010A (Tax-Exempt Bonds), \$57,165,000 School Improvement Bonds, Series 2010B (Federally Taxable – Build America Bonds – Direct Payment) (the "2010 BABs"), and \$11,260,000 School Improvement Bonds, Series 2010C (Federally Taxable – Qualified School Construction Bonds – Direct Payment); and

WHEREAS, all of the 2010 BABs, which are scheduled to mature on December 1 in the years 2030 (in the aggregate principal amount of \$8,120,000, subject to mandatory sinking fund redemption on December 1 in the years 2027 through 2029), 2035 (in the aggregate principal amount of \$14,545,000, subject to mandatory sinking fund redemption on December 1 in the years 2031 through 2034), and 2043 (in the aggregate principal amount of \$34,500,000, subject to mandatory sinking fund redemption on December 1 in the years 2036 through 2042), are still outstanding, and are subject to extraordinary optional redemption prior to maturity by and at the sole option of the School District, either in whole or in part on any date at a redemption price equal to 100% of the principal amount of the bonds to be redeemed, plus any accrued interest to the redemption date, in the event that the Direct Payments (meaning, credit payments allowed with respect to the 2010 BABs that are payable directly to the School District by the U.S. Treasury as provided in Section 6431 of the Code (as defined in the Original Bond Legislation), in lieu of the federal income tax credits that would otherwise be available to holders of such obligations) relating to the 2010 BABs to be redeemed cease or are reduced; and

WHEREAS, through the federal government's action and/or inaction relating to what is commonly referred to as "budget sequestration", the School District received a Direct Payment from the U.S. Treasury, relating to the June 1, 2013 interest payment on the 2010 BABs, in the amount of \$538,408.38, instead of the expected \$589,713.46, being a reduction of \$51,305.08 (approximately 8.7%), and received correspondence (namely, an "Acknowledgment of your June 1, 2013 Form 8038-CP and notice of reduction to your credit payment") from the U.S. Department of Treasury, dated May 13, 2013, stating the following: "Pursuant to the requirements of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985, as amended, certain automatic reductions take place as of March 1, 2013. These required reductions include a reduction to refundable credits under Internal Revenue Code section 6431 applicable to certain qualified bonds. As a result, your refundable credit payment will be reduced by 8.7%. The sequestration reduction rate will be applied until the end of the fiscal year (September 30, 2013) or intervening Congressional action, at which time the sequestration rate is subject to change."; and

WHEREAS, although this Board has not yet determined to authorize the exercise of the extraordinary option to call the 2010 BABs for redemption and the related sale, issuance and delivery of bonds to refund the 2010 BABs, the Board desires to authorize the Treasurer to file a voluntary notice of the aforementioned facts and events with the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board's Electronic Municipal Market Access electronic repository;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Westlake City School District, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to file a notice with the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board's Electronic Municipal Market Access electronic repository that School District bonds (namely, the 2010 BABs) are subject to an extraordinary optional redemption provision that has been satisfied. That notice shall be substantially in the form on file with the Treasurer, together with any changes and additions deemed necessary in the judgment of the Treasurer.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
