B. Increasing District Revenue (Mays)

- Mr. Mays led a discussion on the potential for the district to raise additional funding using alternative methods. He suggested three possibilities the Board might want to consider:
- 1. The district could propose a local tax (similar to the sin-tax) whereby proceeds from the sale of alcoholic beverages would go to the schools. He asked the Treasurer to explore the practicality of such an initiative.
- 2. Consider the installation of an electronic billboard at the High School to advertise district events. The Board directed the superintendent to ask Mr. Puffer to investigate this possibility further.
- 3. Consider additional advertising through corporate sponsorship or the granting of naming rights in exchange for revenue.

C. Supplemental Contracts (Rocco)

• Ms. Rocco is interested in better understanding the scope of supplemental offerings throughout the district. The Board directed the superintendent to compile a survey of all supplemental offerings in the district including duties, salary and student involvement.
