- C. Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Keenan reported on the following:

- 1. Noted a recent discussion with the OSFC seemed to indicate a decision on awarding the QSCBs would be made as early at August 3rd. He further noted that 30 districts have applied for a total of \$800M in requests.
- 2. Noted that MKC is prepared to handle all required timelines. A draft report was already provided to the Superintendent with a final report due to the Board on August 10.
- 3. Commented he sent a letter to the Westlake City Council about their consideration of a possible joint project between the city, schools and a private entity to turf the existing football stadium. He further noted that Mr. Turk is the community member spearheading this campaign.
- D. Treasurer's Report/Recommendations

Treasurer Pepera provided a brief update on the happenings with HB1. He noted the Governor had recently signed the bill which includes some line-item vetoes – most notably the continuation of a full replacement mechanism for lost personal property as a result of HB66. He further noted the current version of the budget shows a 1% and 2% reduction in basic aid over the next two years and that a possible further reduction could occur in November. It was also noted a challenge was made by an Ohio group regarding the authority of the Governor to utilize VLTs to support the Bill.
