B. Special Reports & Recognitions

Kathi Maxwell, Director of Academic Services, provided an update on the changes at the elementary schools to improve performance within some of the student sub-group levels. She also noted the District will train building principals and instructional leaders to implement a 30 minute period of 'no new instruction' which will be included in the daily curriculum.

C. Superintendent's Report & Facilities Update

Superintendent Palmer noted the following:

- 1. Governor Kasich vetoed several portions of HB64, most notably the removal of the TPP reimbursement provision. We are now facing a \$1.2M reduction next year.
- 2. Planning and discussion continues with the administrative move to Parkside. American Greetings has offered to donate room dividers to facilitate the transition.
- 3. Summer work on our buildings and grounds is progressing.
- 4. Dave Kocevar reports custodial, maintenance and summer workers are doing a great job. Mulch was delivered this past week. The Dover campus parking lot was completely sealed and restriped. Field house brick and scaffolding as well as interior work is progressing although an extension to August 14th was granted due to related weather.
- 5. Most of our staffing needs have been resolved.
- 6. We are waiting on notification of World School status (IB) for our four elementary schools.
- 7. Administrative Retreat will be held August 5-6.

D. CAC – None.

E. Treasurer's Report/Recommendations

CFO/Treasurer Pepera spoke about the State biennial budget. The District is slated to lose well over \$1.2M each year (beginning in FY17) and will need to be incorporated into the fiscal forecast. He noted a big portion of the loss was due to the elimination of tangible personal property reimbursements the District had been receiving from the State in addition to the State's reliance on local capacity and typology to determine allocations.

On a related fiscal note, Mr. Mays requested a comparative analysis to other districts as it pertains to outsourcing some of their services.
