C. Board Items

Dr. Keenan introduced Galen Schuerlein from Burges & Burges and Kathy Severinski from the Triad Research Group who discussed their findings from a recent community survey soliciting input on the schools and the possibility of a November operating levy. They noted the following themes from their research: the community has high expectations, the District is viewed as a high performing district, and recent budgetary cuts and funding reductions have gone largely unnoticed by the public.

Mr. Cross asked questions about the survey engagement and how respondents were selected. Ms. Schuerlein responded to Mr. Cross and noted the process allows the Board to make an informed decision. Ms. Winter noted that it is just as important to understand qualitative as well as quantitative data when reviewing the results of such surveys. Mr. Falcone noted that Mr. Cross' comments appear to be an attempt to devalue the information being received from individuals who use our services (i.e. parents, taxpayers, business owners). Mrs. Leszynski asked Ms. Schuerlein if there was any question regarding the impact of the recent library levy. Ms. Schuerlein noted there was not a question of this nature contained in the survey due to the renewal status of that levy. Mr. Cross asked if he could see the 25 individuals selected for the interview process, but Ms. Schuerlein indicated that in line with proper protocol, individuals were told their responses were confidential in nature. Superintendent Keenan then followed with a brief presentation which depicted the financial impact of different millage options and the overall need for a November operating levy.

The Treasurer/CFO, or Treasurer Pro Tempore, as the case may be, advised the Board that the notice requirements of Section 121.22 of the Revised Code and the implementing rules adopted by the Board pursuant thereto were complied with for the following meeting.

Mr. Mays moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 13-252

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL CURRENT EXPENSE TAX LEVY AND REQUESTING THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THAT ADDITIONAL LEVY.

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the School District and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation for the purpose of current expenses; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, in order to submit the question of a tax levy pursuant to Section 5705.21 of the Revised Code, this Board must request that the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer certify (i) the total current tax valuation of the School District, and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B), upon receipt of a certified copy of a resolution of this Board declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose, whether it is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, and the Section of the Revised Code authorizing its submission to the electors, and requesting such certification, the County Fiscal Officer is to certify the total current tax valuation of the School District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Westlake City School District, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Declaration of Necessity of Current Expenses Tax Levy.</u> This Board declares that it is necessary to levy, for a continuing period of time, an additional 5.4-mill ad valorem property tax outside of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of current expenses, and that it intends to submit the question of the additional tax levy to the electors at an election on November 5, 2013, as authorized by Section 5705.21 of the Revised Code. If approved, the additional tax would first be levied in tax year 2013, for first collection in calendar year 2014.
- <u>Section 2</u>. <u>Request for Certification</u>. This Board requests the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer to certify to it both (i) the total current tax valuation of the School District, and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the additional levy specified in Section 1.
- <u>Section 3</u>. <u>Certification and Delivery of Resolution to County Fiscal Officer</u>. The Treasurer of this Board is authorized and directed to deliver or cause to be delivered promptly to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer a certified copy of this Resolution.
- <u>Section 4</u>. <u>Compliance with Open Meeting Requirements</u>. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- <u>Section 5.</u> <u>Captions and Headings.</u> The captions and headings in this Resolution are solely for convenience of reference and in no way define, limit or describe the scope or intent of any Sections, subsections, paragraphs, subparagraphs or clauses hereof.
- <u>Section 6</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
