1. Superintendent Transition

- Superintendent Keenan welcomed all visitors in attendance. He provided an overview of the superintendent transition to date. - The District received its ninth consecutive "Excellent" grade on the District Report Card scoring 29/30. It also achieved AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress) designation.
