1. Red Brick Lease

Dr. Keenan distributed a document indicating some issues raised by the Arts Group in relationship to finalizing a lease agreement for the former administration facility. The Board discussed each issue in detail and made comments.

<u>Keenan</u>: – He indicated the recapture provision in the lease needs to be maintained unless the Board considers exploring an alternative contractual option.

<u>Marinucci</u> – He asked Dr. Keenan if the District could offer a land lease only to the group, and sell the building.

<u>Keenan</u> – Using a land lease arrangement has not been explored to date but most likely would not achieve the desired outcome.

Mays – He indicated the recapture provision may be necessary, but the Board could still agree to allow the group to utilize the facility on nights and weekends.

O'Malley – He wondered why the Board could reimburse improvements made to the Bradley Road property in the lease arrangement with the City, but not this particular arrangement. He also commented about the possibility of exploring the Community Learning Center legislation to see if it could be utilized in this situation.

Pepera – He commented he does not recall a provision in the lease agreement whereby the Board would reimburse the City for improvements made to their property. He further stated the statute that deals with Community Learning Center most likely refers to cooperative arrangements between municipal entities. In addition, this type of arrangement would involve a more in-depth business partnership.

Board – The Board agreed at this point they are not interested in being a financial partner with the Arts Council on this arrangement.

The Superintendent and Treasurer agreed to follow up on this discussion and respond in their respective Briefs to questions raised by the Board.
