LeChaix: Would like to see what the public relations firm says before making a decision.

Beal: The Board needs to continue discussions about placing an issue on the ballot.

<u>O'Malley</u>: The Board needs to plan longer than eight months before a levy. He indicated a spring ballot issue would be toward the end of his list of possible dates.
