C. Superintendent's Report

- Tim Freeman, WHS Principal, introduced Kathy McGinty and some WHS students who shared a promotional video on the Leadership Challenge. The students commented on several annual activities such as: leaf raking, Winter Fun Night, Newcomers' Group, Senior Citizens' Prom, Cultural Exchange, Post 911 program, Ohio Prevention Conference, Powder Puff game, Leadership Challenge retreat, and beautification of schools.
- Superintendent Costanza provided the Board with additional school security information. He indicated the installation of a controlled-access system (buzzer) would increase awareness of security. To implement such a system, the District needs to update existing hardware, reallocate some employee (aide) time, develop entry protocol and procedures and notify parents and vendors. He recommends going forward with this project.

Beal: Does senior privilege reduce security at Westlake High School? Superintendent: Yes. Staff needs to reemphasize to students to be vigilant with doors, etc. Wargo: What about employing a security person at Parkside?

Superintendent: We could, but it would cost additional money.

Beal: Investing in technology is permanent, but staff reallocation is less permanent.

O'Malley: He would like to see a school-by-school cost study on this recommendation.

<u>Superintendent</u>: The technology option is \$2,000+ per building, and Project Link would be \$3,000 per building for a total cost of approximately \$28,000.

<u>Wargo</u>: What type of aide time will we lose?

Superintendent: We have a calculation of this.

Wargo: She would like Parkside to have an aide at the door.

<u>Board</u>: The Board agreed to move forward on this project and would like a cost estimate for employing a security employee at Parkside.

President D'Ettorre Wargo declared a brief recess at 6:08 p.m. and resumed the meeting at 6:18 p.m.
