<u>Costanza</u>: Those particular scores are from the beginning of the year and may not be indicative of the testing that will be completed in the second half of the year.

<u>Beal</u>: Is it possible for the athletic director to consider parental input in coaching evaluations?

Costanza: He believes parental input is considered by the Athletic Director.
