The Treasurer advised the Board that the notice requirements of Section 121.22 of the Revised Code and the implementing rules adopted by the Board pursuant thereto were complied with for the meeting.

Mr. Kraft moved the adoption of the following resolution:

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE DISTRICT WILL UTILIZE THE CONSTRUCTION MANAGER AT RISK CONSTRUCTION DELIVERY METHOD FOR THE NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND RELATED WORK AND AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATION TO SOLICIT STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS AND PROPOSALS AND CONDUCT INTERVIEWS OF SHORTLISTED FIRMS.

WHEREAS, the District is building a new elementary school; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has recommended the use of the Construction Manager at Risk construction delivery method; and

WHEREAS, the District must solicit statements of qualifications and proposals for the construction management at risk services for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Administration will involve the architect and legal counsel in the selection process and provide to this Board a recommendation for its consideration; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Westlake City School District, County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, that:

- Section 1. This Board authorizes its administrative team to solicit statements of qualifications and pricing proposals for construction manager at risk services for the new school and related work and to provide a recommendation to the Board for its consideration.
- Section 2.
