B. Special Reports & Recognitions

School Messenger Presentation

Superintendent Palmer, Director of Technology Pete Zagray, and Communications Coordinator Kim Bonvissuto gave an overview of the new community alert system (School Messenger).

C. CAC Report

Tom Horwitz described the background of new member Keith Stuart (pastor, Dover Congregational Church) and asked the Board to approve his application for membership. Mr. Horwitz then requested a new deadline of March 2015 to present their research project findings.

D. Superintendent's Report & Master Facility Plan Report

Superintendent Palmer noted the following:

- 1. Dave Kocevar, Director of Business Affairs, reported that the Field House plans have been approved by the City and the project will be bid out in January with work commencing in February. The project is to be complete by June 2015.
- 2. Provided an update on the workings of the community 20/20 group. He noted recent meetings included a review of potential building options: one building (Pre-K through 4); two-building option (grade level or neighborhood); or three-building option (neighborhood elementary concept), and discussion on the strengths and weaknesses of each design. The next meeting will be December 18th at 6:30 at LBMS Library Media Center.
- 3. Legislative update: HB597 (repeal of Common Core) and 'five of eight' legislation.
- 4. State of Schools address to be held in late January.
- 5. Spoke about the possibility of re-focusing efforts on Permanent Improvement needs and possible consideration of a small PI issue in May 2015.

E. Treasurer's Report/Recommendations

CFO Pepera reviewed the recent Build America Bond debt refunding transaction and noted the District will save \$2.1 million dollars in interest costs over the remaining life of the issue.

President Winter congratulated CFO Pepera on his appointment to the Governmental Accounting Standards Advisory Council.
