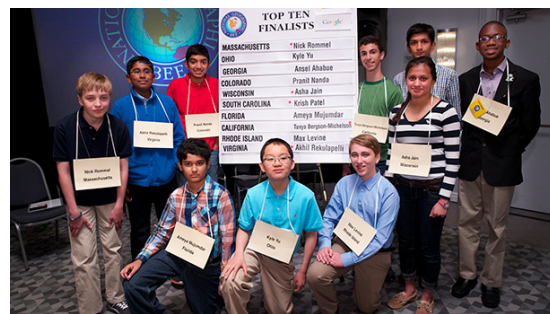
Academic Challenge

Superintendent Search Proceeding

The Westlake Board of Education closed its Superintendent Search on May 23. Board members met May 30 and June 1 with the Ohio School Board Association search firm to go over the initial 24 applicants, who come from Ohio and outside of the state. OSBA is expected to recommend about seven candidates to be interviewed by the Board of Education.

Round 1 interviews are scheduled for June 2 and 3, with second round interviews taking place after the June 9 Board meeting. All interviews will be private. The Board tentatively set June 11 as the date for finalist(s) presentations to the community, which will be invited to participate in a Q&A.

Board President Carol Winter said the Board hopes to have Dr. Keenan's replacement in place prior to his departure on July 31. If the Board does not find a suitable replacement during this process, an interim superintendent will be named and OSBA will begin a new search with no additional consultation fee to the district.
