On Nov. 2, voters will choose the Cuyahoga County Executive who will lead the new government, and their own County Council District Representative among the 11 newly-formed districts.

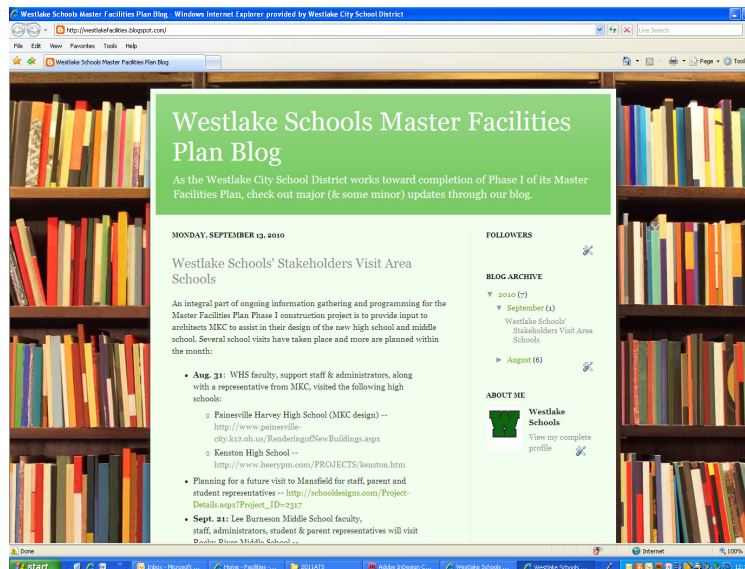
League nonpartisan forums include a brief statement by each candidate, followed by a question and answer session with written questions from the audience.
