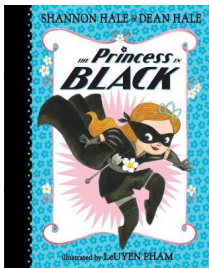




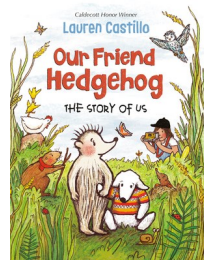
Summer Reading Suggestions

****Read whatever books you want, but here are a few good choices!****

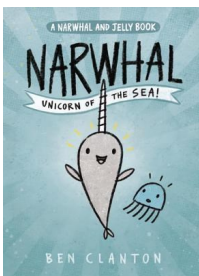


Who says princesses don't wear black? When trouble raises its blue monster head, Princess Magnolia ditches her flouncy dresses and becomes the Princess in Black!

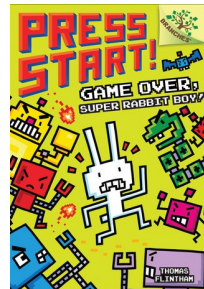

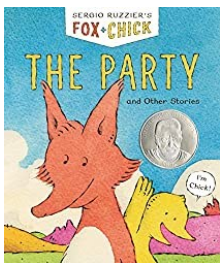

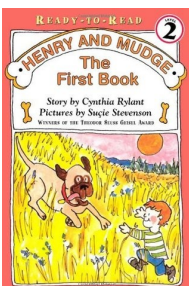
Practical Fox and unpredictable Chick may argue a lot, but in the end they always remember they are friends.

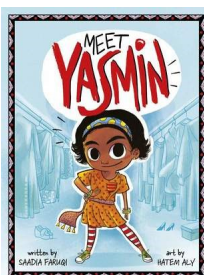
Mia has just discovered that she, and everyone in her family, has superpowers! Now she has to go to superhero school to learn about her skills.

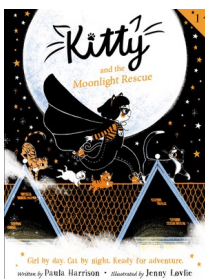
One of my all-time favorite series, everyone should read about Henry and his big dog Mudge.

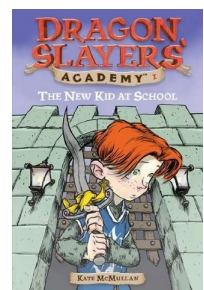
