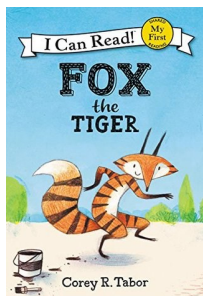




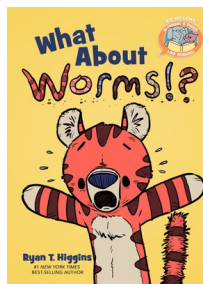

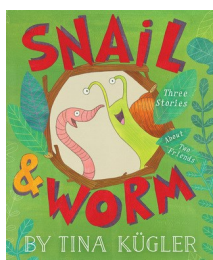
Fox wishes he were a fast speedy tiger. But then he meets someone who wants to be a clever fox instead!

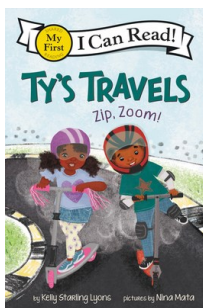

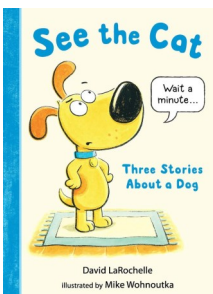

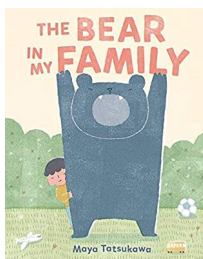

See Max. Max is not a cat--Max is a dog. But much to Max's dismay, the book keeps instructing readers to "see the cat." Even though he is a *DOG!*

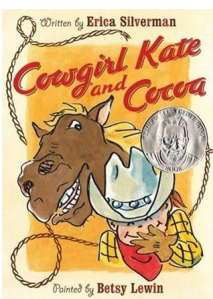

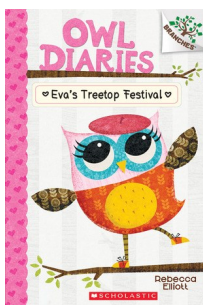
What would it be like if there was a BEAR in your family? Some of you might already know!

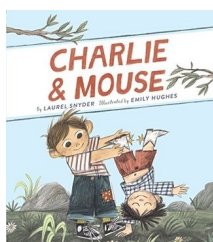

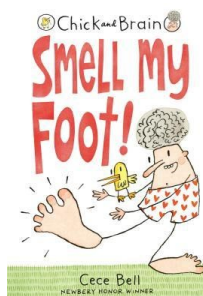
