



COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS CHECKLIST

1. DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY (EVERYONE)

- Return the Intent to Participate, Transcript Request, and Acknowledgement Form to your school counselor
- Apply directly to the college or university you plan to attend
- Turn in a copy of "College-Ready" test scores to your school counselor

2. REGISTERING FOR CLASS (AT WHS)

- Include the CCP class with your schedule requests during scheduling Jan. 29th – Feb. 2nd
- Turn in copy of test scores for course eligibility for PreCalc, Calc, Stats, Biology, or Environmental Science

3. REGISTERING FOR CLASS (OFF-CAMPUS)

- Research which class(es) you want to take and any additional eligibility requirements
- First meet* with your school counselor for a course authorization form
- Then* schedule an appointment with a CCP college advisor to register for classes
- Bring a copy of your schedule back to your school counselor
- Sign up for CCP Remind Notifications (text @cd2ked to 81010)
- Check with the WHS library 1st before purchasing any textbooks from a college bookstore
